### Download APP

Visit App Store ( iOS and Android ), search "WiWo".

### AP configuration

Make sure the device is power on. Wait until rapid flashing RED LED, then long press the button until it changes to rapid flashing BLUE LED. If firstly the device is not flashing RED rapidly please long press the button until rapid flashing RED LED.

- (Necessary step only for IOS users) Go to your smart phone or tablet device's WiFi settings, and select "WiWo-Allone."
- Go Back and open the App"WiWo."
- Tap " " symbol, then tap "more", then tap "AP configuration".
- Select the specific WiFi router/modern that your Allone is desired to connect to. Enter password of the desired Wi-Fi router/modem.
- Tap"OK".
- If it's connected successfully, the Allone will restart.

### Device management

Go back to [Device List] and tap"+", then tap" Search" . Once the search is completed(it should only take a few seconds) and the Allone appears on the list, select it. Now, your Allone is ready to use!

### IR learning

Press the button constantly in the App(this button is in learning mode), then press the same function button towards to AllOne in your old remote control.

### Scene

Go to Scene and you can add several devices and scene.

### Backlight indicator

Backlight	Status
Constantly in red	IR learning
Fast blinking in blue (5times/s)	AP configuration
Constantly in blue	Connecting to WiFi router
Slow blinking in blue	connected to WiFi and cloud
Slow blinking in purple	Connected to WiFi but disconnected to cloud

### Installation

Put it on the desk

Paste on the wall

Fix on the ceiling

### Automatic matching

You can select any one of AC brand and try to control your device(suggestion: first Brand is mostly match) If it is successful you can control your device without learning every button, it is a fast solution.

### Reset button

1. Reset to defaults: Connecting AllOne to power, press reset button constantly until it is in fast blinking with red light(5times/s).
2. AP configure: Connecting AllOne to power, press reset button constantly until it is fast blinking with blue light (5times/s).

Allone will be sleep mode after a munite

### SAFETY MEASURES
